SHAKOPEE Library

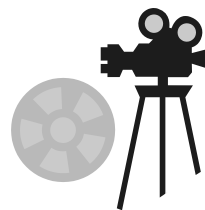

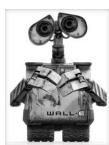
